### LGBTQ+ businesses be wary of Stripe

For LGBTO+ businesses who need online payment systems, we have some advice: Stripe, a major supplier, will cancel your payment system with them if you feature what they consider to be 'adult' content which they consider to be

controversial. Stripe told PinkUk that it could not support our site and cancelled our agreement with no notice.

We recommend that LGBTQ+ businesses look to other payment systems such as Paypal.
