series of events and culminated in the biggest Pride parade ever organized locally with a festival at the National Waterfront Museum and Museum Green. The organisers say Swansea Pride will remain a free to attend event. Like last time, the weekend events will be held at the National Waterfront Museum and Museum Green.
